- Nominating (Chair, Vice-Chair, 2 Directors):** Recommends suitable candidates to fulfill Board vacancies.
- Fundraising (3 Directors, 3 Community members, Director of Philanthropy):** Assists in the planning, coordination and implementation of all fundraising activities.
- Member Outreach & Quality Committee (3 Director, 2 Community members and Member Navigator):** Promote the Centre in the community as the facility of choice for psychosocial support within North Simcoe and ensuring our programs support the Centre Mission and Vision.
- Facility Management (3 Directors, 2 Community Members and Director Emeritus):** Recommends and reviews current facility and oversight of relocation and design of new Centre.

The GBCSC is a place of home and vitality for people living with cancer, their families and caregivers. Programs are offered free to members; no medical referral required. Our programs are selected for their contributions to the psychosocial well-being of our members.

Psychosocial support is a specialty in cancer care concerned with understanding and treating the social, psychological, emotional, spiritual and functional aspects of cancer, from prevention throughout bereavement. It is a whole-person approach to cancer care that addresses a range of very human needs that can improve quality of life for people affected by cancer.
